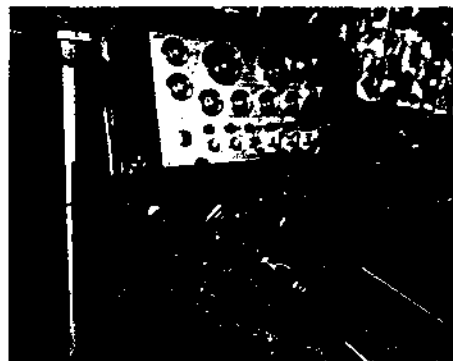
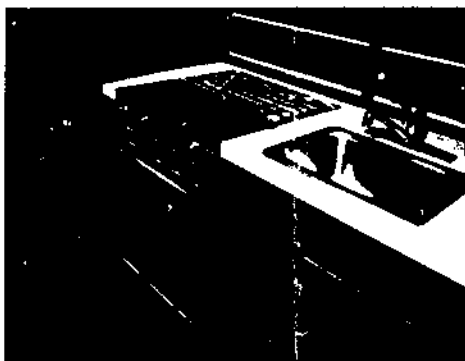
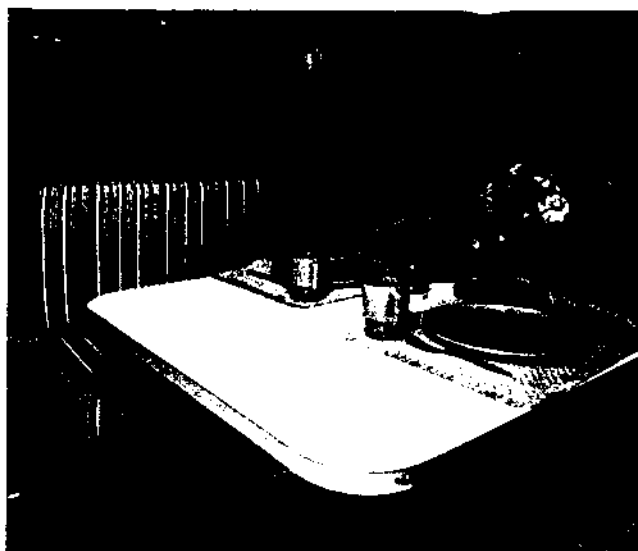
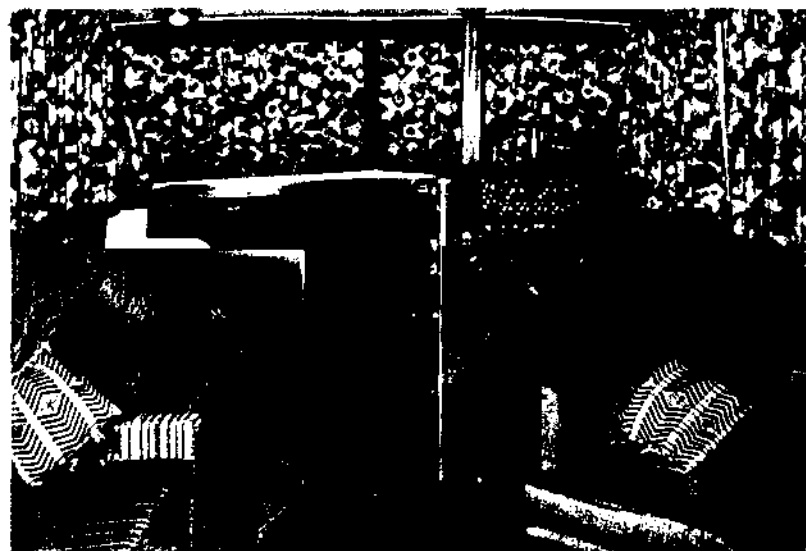
The Pequod 34, like its namesake, reflects incomparable ruggedness. The graceful sheer and modified vee hull make her one of the dryest and most seaworthy designs afloat. You can accept the challenge of nearly any weather with confidence knowing that the Pequod 34 exceeds the highest construction standards. Her hand-laid fiberglass, lap strake hull ranges in thickness from more than a quarter inch at the toe rail to over three-quarters of an inch below the water line. That's the kind of construction that you can safely stake your life on. That sort of secure confidence can be extremely reassuring.

The unique hull design of the Pequod 34 also makes her an exceptionally economical boat to operate. The hull requires a minimum amount of power from her V-drive engines to raise her up on plane. She will actually offer true trawler economy at planing speeds. This means greater fuel savings and also substantially increased range. The Pequod 34 is available with several power plant options, including diesel engines.

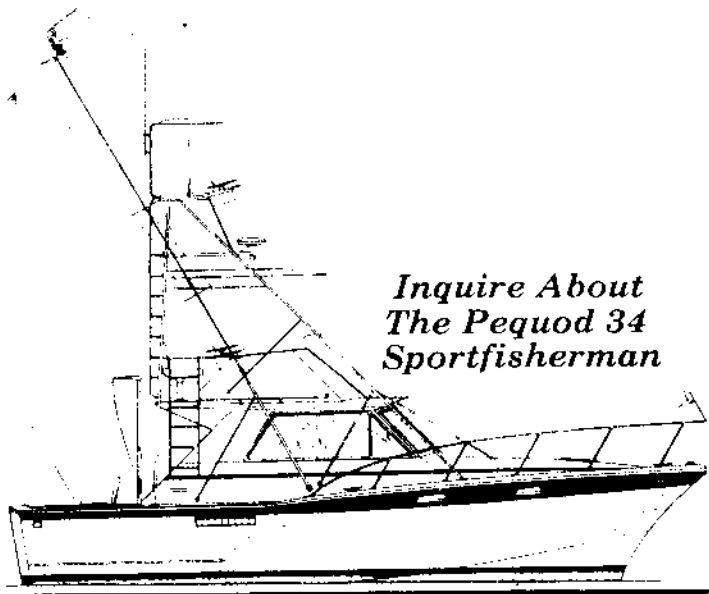
Above decks, the Pequod 34 displays thorough planning. Her large bridge seats five comfortably and offers the helmsman excellent visibility. The large cockpit is also totally visible from the bridge, a feature that is important to any serious fisherman.

The lavish use of hand rubbed mahogany creates a rich, warm atmosphere in the spacious salon and throughout the cabin. Plan "A" sleeps four, Plan "B" sleeps six in three staterooms, and Plan "C" also sleeps six while offering a full-sized dinette.

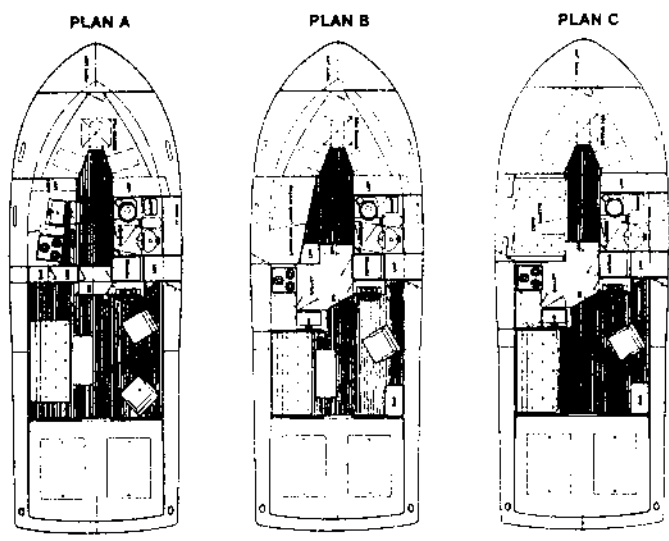
